Heaven and Earth Tarot

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.”

The *Heaven and Earth Tarot* brings forth the glory of the Heavens in a way in which we can connect to it on a daily basis. This deck is for people who see the Divine in the everyday. The connections between the mundane and the spiritual appear in every card of the deck. The artwork in this deck blends the images of the Waite Smith system with the deeper occult wisdom of a Thoth deck.

Jack Sephiroth's artwork displays a feel for the classical. This artwork reminds us of the Pre-Raphaelite movement which looked to Nature for their art. Artists blended the colors of the earthly world in with spiritual and social themes. They sought to find a deeper connection between life and spirituality. While Sephiroth's art grounds the *Heaven and Earth*

deck to this form, it elevates our desire to connect back to the divine in every image. Lean into the artwork to shape the stories it can tell you.

Each card highlights the connection between the Heavenly correspondences: the Hebrew alphabet as well as the meaning of the Tarot. The images shine the light on ways to see more clearly how the Earthly factors unite with the Heavens in the Mundane World. The cards bring into focus ideas and images that may seem unclear but once the connections are made, the messages can come through to each person who reads with the deck.

We can pull a card from the deck to hear a daily message or we can use the cards in spreads to connect with the Divine from which we are in need of hearing. The messages one seeks will be present if one is open to connections with Spiritual World.

Messages to you can be quiet or loud depending on what you ask the cards. Are you ready to dive deep into the *Heaven and Earth Tarot*? If you are, then it is ready to share its road to devotional work with you. The deck - not differently from the 1909 Tarot by Arthur Edward Waite and Pamela Colman Smith - follows sometimes a Christian symbolism. However, the connection between the Divine - or, as some may say, the Higher Self and the Spiritual World - and the Mundane - or the Lower Self or the Material World - is the same independently of belief: humanity lives on Earth, but seeks the Heaven.

UNLOCKING THE MEANINGS OF THE HEAVEN AND EARTH TAROT

This booklet contains information for each one of the 78 cards. There is information specific to unlocking the symbols on each card. A short list of selected interpretations appears for both upright and reversed (reading the card upside down) positions. Use this information as a starting point to help you crack the code for reading Tarot. Be patient when working with the *Heaven and Earth Tarot!* Assigning meaning to your question may not come easy. It can take a while to decipher what the cards say, especially when many cards appear on the table. Tarot cards contain a lot of visual information. Slow down, give your intuition space to unravel the mysteries.

Close your eyes, open your mind to the world of possibilities Tarot brings. Take a deep breath and allow the characters on each card to guide you into a world of connecting with your intuition. Use this booklet's information to kick-start your intuition. If this booklet conflicts with what the card imagery tells you, go with your gut instinct. Tarot is not an exact science. Understanding Tarot meanings takes practice. When you learn to decode the symbols each card contains, you'll find each card contains a wealth of knowledge inside. Enjoy this process. There are no wrong answers for interpreting the cards.

All Numerals (the cards between 1 and 10) of each suit have written English keywords on the cards. Keywords are supposed to help and guide the Reader, and not to limit his or her intuition. They are

just a seed, or a starting point for the interpretation. When first Reading with this deck, possibly, the keywords will be used more frequently, but with experience, a Reader will learn to go beyond their simple words and tap deeper meanings for his or her interpretations.

0 . The Fool

A fool stands at the edge of a cliff. Their clothing displays a Jewish tree of life on them. The robes are dark in color, and a mantel of moss has been placed on their shoulders. The inside of their cloak is colored with fire, reminding us that fire can be a creative force as well as destructive. A small bag is tied to a branch which hangs over their shoulder. It holds the possessions the fool needs as they set out on this journey. A rose is delicately held between their fingers of their left hand. A dove flies in the air above. A wolf pup howls at the Fool by their feet.

Keyword: Innocence

Hebrew letter: Aleph, meaning ox

Correspondences: Air, Aquarius, Uranus

Upright: new journey; beginnings; innocence; freedom; push through the challenges; playful behavior; leap of faith.

Reversed: reluctance to change; being blocked; a desire to stay where you are; feeling restrained; fixed position; unblock yourself.

I . The Magician

A man stands in front of a table filled with implements. He wears a red robe left open and has a white crown and white pants on. His right hand points

downward, while his left rises high in the air holding a brightly glowing wand. A simple wooden table is placed before him with six tools. There is a cup, a disc, a sword, a wand, a scroll, and a caduceus. Green grasses mix with roses and lilies in front of the table as well. The Magician's face appears intent on the actions he is performing.

Keyword: Willpower

Hebrew letter: Beth, meaning house

Correspondences: Mercury, Virgo, Gemini

Upright: external knowledge; manifesting desires; channeling internal will; channel your resources for a single purpose; self-control; study; self-mastery; masculine divine.

Reversed: abuse of power; manipulative; too much control; disappointment; wielding too much power; controlling the process; avoid perfectionism.

II - The High Priestess

A woman sits on a pedestal. She wears a long dress and cloak. Her hood is up. An ankh hangs around her neck and a book with many tabs rests in her lap. She is barefoot and her feet dangle over the water. A black pillar borders the left of the card. It is marked with a B. A white pillar borders the right side of the card. It has a J on it. The symbol for the triple goddess appears above the woman's head. A camel can be seen behind her. Mist obscures the area behind this scene. A sword with its point placed into the water appears to her left. The reflection of the moon appears near her feet.

Keyword: Wisdom

Hebrew letter: Gimel, meaning camel

Correspondences: Moon, Cancer

Upright: close your eyes; listen to your intuition; meditate; trust the universe; be a keeper of secrets; commune with the divine; listen to your guides; understand shamanistic visions; lunar magics; divine feminine.

Reversed: inability to trust yourself; act inauthentically; doubt your abilities; misalignment with your soul's purpose; allow others to tell you how to think.

III · The Empress

A fair-haired maiden sits on a wooden throne decorated with flowers and Celtic knot-work. She leans against a lavish fur backing. She appears to be daydreaming. Her dress is long and white. She has rolled her sleeves to the elbows and holds a flower scepter in one hand. A crown of flowers appears on her head and she has a white pearl necklace that lays over her dress. A finely crafted, wooden, lyre sits next to her. A field of wheat fills the scene in front of her and there is a swiftly flowing waterfall and stream behind her.

Keyword: Nurturing

Hebrew letter: Daleth, meaning door

Correspondences: Venus, Taurus, Libra

Upright: abundance; feeling creative; sustained nourishment; enjoy the beauty of the earth; cultivate creative desires; love yourself; fertility; feeling happy and fulfilled; motherhood.

Reversed: scarcity; overwhelm; disconnect; feeling scared or stifled; poor resource management; creativity blocks; escapism.

IV · The Emperor

An elderly Emperor sits on his stone throne. He wears a red gown which can be seen under the battle-worn armor he continues to wear. His cloak is heavily decorated with golden clasps. The astrological symbol for Mars appears in bold red over his left shoulder. He holds a golden orb in his left hand and matching golden scepter in his right. His crown is also gold. The arm rests of his throne are decorated with the alchemical symbol for Sulfer, which is a highly toxic element. A well-used shield has been placed by his feet. It bears a ram's head. A spear rests to one side of his throne as well. There is not much to see behind this throne. A haze obscures the scene. We can see some sharp rocks jutting up from a barren landscape.

Keyword: Stewardship

Hebrew letter: Heh, meaning window

Correspondences: Aries, Mars

Upright: power; define boundaries; guiding the shape of things to come; authority; protection; understanding the concrete world; focus on action and results.

Reversed: chaotic times; lack of good boundaries; being too rigid; instability; ignorance; too much micromanagement; reflect before moving forward.

V · The Hierophant

A religious figure sits on a chair flanked by two animals: a bull and an elephant. He wears white and red robes decorated with pentacles and the astrological symbol for Taurus. His crown has three tiers and a six-pointed star glows over it. Three cross-

es drape down his religious stole. His right hand points high in the air with two fingers, while his left grasps a staff bearing a Borromean Ring representing strength in unity. Two columns flank the figure. The one on the left has the alchemical symbols for air and fire, while the one on the right has water and earth on it. A pure white dove hovers above his raised fingers. A red carpet lines the stairs in front of this religious figure bearing a sun, the astrological symbol for Taurus and Jupiter, and two crossed keys. Two followers wearing robes supplicate themselves before the Hierophant.

Keyword: Guidance

Hebrew letter: Vav, meaning nail

Correspondences: Taurus, Venus

Upright: receive knowledge from a higher source; connect to the divine; awaken to understanding; teaching; use tools to get a message across; religion; caretaker of spiritual knowledge; channel divine messages.

Reversed: a closed mind; turn away from the light; challenge authority; not listening to others; ignore advice; being a trailblazer; unable to handle change well; detached from life.

VI · *The Lovers*

An almost naked man holds a naked woman in his arms. He wears leaves around his waist, keeping his modesty intact. He has short brown hair and gazes into the woman's eyes. She has long brown hair and reaches out to touch his cheek with one arm. She returns his gaze. Beyond and high in the clouds appears an angel with hands stretched out wide. This

figure seems to be blessing the choice the two people have made between one another. As a result, circles of bright light appear around the lovers' heads. A ring of clouds surrounds a sword hovering in the air marking the contract made. Two bushes appear by the Lovers' side: and one ripe with fruit. A snake wraps itself around the living bush.

Keyword: Connection

Hebrew letter: Zayin, meaning sword

Correspondences: Gemini, Mercury

Upright: make a choice; seek connections; passion; enjoy time with others; unity; submit to the greater good; blend opposing ideas together; self-acceptance.

Reversed: loveless relationship; hurtful emotions; lack of empathy; reassess position in the relationship; forced into something.

VII · *The Chariot*

An armored charioteer stands in the carriage. He holds a wand in his right hand. The armor is mostly grey with some bits of gold for accents. The pauldrons have crescent moons with faces melded into them. His helm has three eight-pointed stars affixed to it. The face shield is down and we cannot see who is behind the metal. A cloth showing the night sky has been draped over the tent, connecting the powers of this charioteer with the night sky. Wings are affixed to the front of the carriage. There are no reins holding the chariot to the creatures which draw it. Two sphinxes, one black and one white sit in front of the chariot, their faces looking in two different directions. The chariot heads away from a city and waterway in the background.

Keyword: Victory

Hebrew letter: Cheth, meaning fence

Correspondences: Cancer, Moon

Upright: take swift action; travel; guide destiny with intuition; trust the path; going places; seize the moment.

Reversed: clarify goals; gain traction; a singular focus; ground yourself; stuck in place.

VIII - Strength

A maiden with long red hair reaches down to soothe a lion who appears to be upset. A wreath of red and white flowers crowns her head. A lemniscate appears above her head. She wears a long, baggy dress made of thin fabric. It hangs loosely off her frame. The lion looks battle-worn and agitated, its mouth is slightly open and has exposed fangs. It does not look at the woman but off to the edge of a card where a snake slithers into the image. The lion has a symbol branded into its haunch. A serpent slithers in from the right side of the card. The figures are placed in a field with rocky mountains in the distance.

Keyword: Power

Hebrew letter: Teth, meaning serpent

Correspondences: Leo, Sun

Upright: harness inner strength; trust; embrace unique talents; courage; facing adversity.

Reversed: trust yourself; weaknesses; insurmountable problems; failure.

IX - The Hermit

An old man wears a long robe. The robe reflects the light of the area, getting darker near the ground and more white as it enters the ambient light of the

lamp. He grips a staff in one hand and holds out a lantern with his other. The light from within the lamp appears as an eight-pointed star. It provides just enough illumination to show the man's face. He appears lost in his own thoughts. He stands high above a snowy mountain range.

Keyword: Introspection

Hebrew letter: Yod, meaning open hand

Correspondences: Virgo, Mercury

Upright: reflection; solitude; a deeper understanding; prepare to help others; seek answers within.

Reversed: isolation; keep things to yourself; feeling blocked.

X · Wheel of Fortune

A giant clock-work wheel hangs in the sky. This intricate golden machine has various cogs and pieces showing. Eight round disks adorn the machine's face. Roman and Hebrew letters alternate every other disk. The Roman letters spell TARO when looked at clockwise. The Hebrew letters spell Yod, Heh, Vav, Heh, which loosely translates into one of the Jewish names of God. Both are spiritual teaching tools to gain higher knowledge. For more alchemical symbols appear on the spokes of the machine's inner disk. A sphinx sits on top of the wheel, an Anubis creature appears on the right of the machine, and a snake on the left. Four creatures holding open books sit among clouds in the four corners of the card. From left to right there is a human, an eagle, a lion, and a bull.

Keyword: Evolution

Hebrew letter: Caph, meaning fist

Correspondences: Jupiter, Pisces, Sagittarius

Upright: karma; understand cycles; fate; good luck and fortune; question reality.

Reversed: resistance to change; bad luck and fortune; learn to ride the waves; change is constant; stuck.

XI · Justice

A fair-haired woman stands between two light-colored pillars. She wears red robes with gold pauldrons. A thick white blindfold has been placed over her eyes. A crown hovers over her head. She holds a set of scales in one hand. One of the plates has a feather in it. The other is empty. In her other hand, she wields a sword. It stays high in the air. She appears to be in stasis as if she is waiting for an action to come before her before imparting some witness. The astrological sign for Libra appears on a veil that is behind her.

Keyword: Karma

Hebrew letter: Lamed, meaning goad

Correspondences: Libra, Venus

Upright: balance; take responsibility for your actions; negotiating circumstances; do the right thing.

Reversed: a loss against you; poor decisions; take justice into your own hands; block an outcome.

XII · The Hanged Man

A man dangles from a single foot by a rope clasped with an ankh. The other foot dangles freely behind the taut leg at an angle. He wears blue shorts which are knotted in front. His arms bend at their elbows and rest behind the man's back. A six-pointed star appears tattooed across his chest. His eyes are closed and his face appears serene, no pain visible. The

bough from which he hangs has been shaped into an upward-pointing triangle, the branches growing up and out at odd angles. A serpent crosses the bar. Two more triangles appear one behind the shoulders of the man, facing down. And the third appears behind the man's head, it points upwards.

Keyword: Ordeal

Hebrew letter: Mem, meaning water

Correspondences: Water, Pisces, Neptune

Upright: sacrifice and surrender; enlightenment; perspective; relax; dedication.

Reversed: stagnation; selfish; tune into nature; awake to challenges.

XIII · Death

A massive white horse with a skeletal rider approaches a group of people. The horse's eyes glow orange and steam blows through its nostrils. Red reins connect the horse to its skeletal rider. The skeleton wears red-tinted armor. A silver cross appears on the chest plate. The face plate is up, displaying the grotesque form underneath. The skeleton holds a black banner with a rose on it. His scythe has been affixed to a holster on the horse. Four people are on the ground. Two towers can be seen off in the distance through the haze.

Keyword: Transformation

Hebrew letter: Nun, meaning fish

Correspondences: Scorpio, Mars, Pluto

Upright: transformation; rebirth; a spiritual end; let go; evolution.

Reversed: reluctance to change; obsessive thoughts; holding back; stuck in repetition.

XIV · Temperance

An angel stands with one foot on land and one in water. They are dressed in a white gown with alchemical symbols printed on the fabric. They hold two cups in each hand, liquid flowing between the two vessels, mixing. Their hair is long and brown and their wings are stretched out wide. The angel does not look at what they are doing. Their gaze appears straight ahead looking at an unknown person. Water splashes up from the river and this does not phase the angel. Yellow flowers grow off to one side of the angel. A crown appears over two mountain peaks far in the distance.

Keyword: Healing

Hebrew letter: Samekh, meaning tent peg

Correspondences: Sagittarius, Jupiter

Upright: moderation; focus attention; spiritual transformation; blending; practicing self-care; restoration.

Reversed: exhaustion; intolerance; external pressures; stop compromising; find your flow.

XV · The Devil

A man and a woman appear chained to a ring on a pedestal. A tight circlet appears around each of their necks. They wear cloths wrapped around the lower halves of their body. The man has his tied in a knot. The woman holds hers close to her waist. She has red hair and rests one arm on her head. He has both his hands free. Horns sprout from their heads. The Devil perches on the pedestal above them. His face appears as a goatish skull, and he has the body of a man. His legs are hairy and end in the hoofs

of a goat. He holds his hands in a mock illusion of The Magician card. Reminding the two figures who is in control here. The hand which points up has the symbol for Saturn carved into it. The hand pointing down holds a flaming torch. An inverted pentagram hovers between The Devil's horns and wings.

Keyword: Excess

Hebrew letter: Ayin, meaning none/void

Correspondences: Capricorn, Saturn

Upright: strong desires; addictions; temptations; fear and confusion; stop giving your power away; embrace the trickster.

Reversed: avoidance; abandon addictions; remove peer pressure; abandon temptations.

XVI · *The Tower*

A tower has been struck by lightning. The lightning is long, bright, and appears like a dragon in the sky. It sets fire to the top levels of the building, blowing it clear off. Sparks rain down in the form of Hebrew yod letters. Two people also fling themselves off the tower, hoping for a better ending. The tower sits on a rocky outcropping. It is hard to tell if the water is below or not. The sky fills with dark clouds indicating more nasty weather incoming.

Keyword: Destruction

Hebrew letter: Pe, meaning mouth

Correspondences: Mars, Scorpio, Aries

Upright: upheaval; destruction of old ways; temporary destruction; flash of inspiration.

Reversed: delay change; rejection; surrender; necessary lessons.

XVII · The Star

A young woman with blonde hair kneels by the lake's edge. She pours water from one pot onto the land behind her head. She pours water from a second pot over the lake where it ripples out making waves. The woman wears only a white skirt around her waist. Her eyes are closed and she appears happy in her work. High above her are eight stars. Seven of them have the symbols for the seven astrological planets. The final star has eight points and glows big and bright in the sky. An ibis watches a safe spot under a tree on the shoreline. White flowers grow from a spot in the water in front of the woman.

Keyword: Hope

Hebrew letter: Tzaddi, meaning fishhook

Correspondences: Aquarius, Saturn, Uranus

Upright: hope; blessings; dreams; cleansing and renewal; purification; dream big.

Reversed: deny inner truth; ignore signals; lack of vision; ignore intuition.

XVIII · The Moon

Two towers frame the light of a full moon onto the grounds below. A feminine face appears inside the moon, eyes closed. Half of each tower is light, half is framed in the shadows. A black and white spotted dog howls from its spot on the left side of the river. A fuzzy white wolf stands on the right side of the river, also howling at the moon. A crab-like beetle rises up from the water, its wings spread out under the light. Eighteen yods hover in the space between the tower just under the moon. The river meanders from the slopes of the land up into sharp mountains in the distance.

Keyword: Mystery

Hebrew letter: Qoph, meaning the back of the head

Correspondences: Pisces, Jupiter, Neptune

Upright: deal with uncertainty; night-time dreams; look past illusions; introspection; face your fears.

Reversed: lack of clarity; decipher shadows; inability to separate fantasy from reality.

XIX · *The Sun*

A toddler sits on the back of a white horse. His arms are spread way out and he waves a large banner in bright red to one side. He wears a headdress with a single red feather on his head. A smile of pure happiness spreads across his face. The horse appears to be in motion. Its mane and tail billow in the action of being outside and alive. A handmade stone wall separates the figures from a section of a garden containing huge sunflowers. They grow bright yellow and reach out for the life-sustaining force of the sun which appears above them. The sun has twenty-two rays coming out of it. Twelve of the rays feature orbs with each one of the zodiac signs in it. An eight-pointed star gives the sun a shape, while a masculine face appears in the center disc of the sun.

Keyword: Clarity

Hebrew letter: Resh, meaning the front of the head

Correspondences: Sun, Leo

Upright: joy; success; renewal; receiving nourishment; optimism; take charge of your life.

Reversed: bullying; losing control; rushing into the moment; spinning out of control.

XX . Judgement

An angel with short hair raises their head to blow into a golden horn. A flag with a red plus sign rolls in the wind. Six coffins rise up from the water below and six figures stand up. Two men, two women, and two children stand out from the boxes to look at the angel above them. They stretch out their arms and praise the call. Mountains jut out in the distance past the horizon. Clouds obscure parts of the angel and the sun which dimly illuminates the world below.

Keyword: Ending

Hebrew letter: Shin, meaning tooth

Correspondences: Fire, Scorpio, Pluto

Upright: resurrection; rebirth; heed spirit's call; return to the source; time to move on.

Reversed: resist the call; avoid connections with others; ask questions; hold yourself back.

XXI . The World

A dancer hovers in the air spinning two wands in each hand. A purple ribbon wraps around her body dressing her lightly. Waves of activated energy appear in circles around each part of her figure. She is encased in a wreath of green boughs. The boughs tie onto one another at the top and bottom with a red lemniscate. Four figures appear out of the clouds. A long-haired person appears in the top left corner. The head of an eagle peers at the man from the top right corner. The face of bull peers from the lower-left corner. A lion stares from the lower right corner.

Keyword: Unity

Hebrew letter: Tav, meaning cross

Correspondences: Saturn, Capricorn, Aquarius

Upright: reintegration; feeling complete; milestone achieved; gratitude; becoming whole; maturity.
Reversed: bad ending; mourning for lost items; let go of a situation.

Ace of Cups

A hand pushes through the cloud holding an ornately decorated cup. Four founts pour water out and over the pond. A dove hovers in the air. It holds a disc with a cross in it. A lotus flower and several lily pads float in the pond below. Many yods hover in-between the streams.

Keyword: Emotional Source

Correspondences: Water, Neptune

Upright: new emotional beginnings; compassion; initial emotional response; emotional outpour.

Reversed: overwhelmed; emotional limitations; withholding; inability to connect emotionally.

Two of Cups

Two lovers embrace one another as water streams up from a cup placed on either side of them. These streams of water flow together forming a flower. She wears a long white dress which exposes her shoulder. A crown of green appears on her head. He wears grey clothing with a black doublet. A crown of orange flowers adorns his head. Two spirit dolphins appear in the water dancing. A caduceus with a lion's head appears where the two water streams mingle.

Keyword: Love

Correspondences: Water, Venus, Uranus, Cancer

Upright: spiritual love; capacity to grow; emotional completion; a harmonious relationship.

Reversed: empty promises; emotional opposition; inability to deepen relationships.

Three of Cups

Three women raise their cups high into the air. They wear loose clothing and dance around a tree whose branches expose the full moon above. The tree spreads out above them all. Each branch contains ripe purple grapes, ready for harvest. The three ladies dance around the tree in celebration of the bounty they are receiving.

Keyword: Abundance

Correspondences: Water, Mercury, Saturn, Cancer

Upright: friendship; a tryst; community; create happiness; hospitality.

Reversed: unfulfilled; failure to connect; withdrawing from society; overindulgence.

Four of Cups

A boy rests against the trunk of a tree. His arms are crossed across his chest. A hand emerges from a cloud with a cup. There are three other cups standing on the ground. The tree is tall and has many branches and leaves on it.

Keyword: Blended Pleasure

Correspondences: Water, Moon, Jupiter, Cancer

Upright: boredom; contemplation; take a break; evaluate the position; do it alone; stalemate.

Reversed: find something new; stretch and move around; find new inspiration.

Five of Cups

A figure dressed all in black looks down at the ground. There are three cups in front of them which

have been spilled. Red liquid pours into the ground. Two still remain upright. A city which can be reached by bridge appears in the distance. The person does not move, disturbed by the event which has taken place.

Keyword: Loss in Pleasure

Correspondences: Water, Mars, Scorpio

Upright: depression; hopelessness; give up; disappointment over a loss; grief for the past.

Reversed: recovery; renewal; renewed kinship; recover from loss; block capacity for joy.

Six of Cups

A woman wraps an arm around a child. She holds a cup filled with plants. Six more cups surround the two women as they gaze at one another. Lush plants grow in all the cups and in a few extra pots placed all around in the greenhouse. They enjoy a moment of solidarity while in a building. A shield with a cross appears on a wall. The sun shines brightly on a field of wheat outside, a stark contrast to the life growing inside the building.

Keyword: Pleasure

Correspondences: Water, Sun, Scorpio

Upright: imagination; nostalgia; seek solace; reunion; give and receive from the heart.

Reversed: too much reality; growing old; focused on time; longing for the past; immaturity; missing out.

Seven of Cups

A brunette wearing dark clothes stares at the clouds above her. Her hands lift up. She seems ready to select one of the seven cups which are in front of her.

INTRODUCTION TO TAROT

Tarot's origins are rooted in myth. However, we can trace parts of the history back through the years and several cultures. Playing cards were invented in China, before 1000AD. Traders distributed the cards through trade routes all over the continents. The first appearance of Tarot as we know it dates back to 1400s Italy. This deck, known as the Visconti, was used to play a popular card game known as Tarocchi. In 1781, Antoine Court de Gébelin, an occultist, was the first to associate the Tarot with occult and divination practices.

In 1910, Arthur Edward Waite commissioned Pamela Coleman Smith to draw artwork for a new type of Tarot deck — known today as the Waite Smith deck. Smith added illustrations to all 78 cards. In 1944 Aleister Crowley created his own version, the *Thoth Tarot*, featuring the artwork of Lady Frieda Harris. The rest of all modern decks can tie their roots back into either the Thoth or the Rider Waite Smith decks.

Tarot is a wonderful tool for divination and insight. A standard pack includes 78 cards and has a distinctive structure: a Major Arcana and a Minor Arcana. The twenty-two Major Arcana cards describe common archetypes to all cultures. The *Heaven and Earth Tarot* lists these in Roman numerals starting with 0 and ending with XXI.

The remaining 56 cards belong to the Minor Arcana. Four suits, each with its own symbol: Cups, Pentacles, Wands and Swords. Each suit ties into one of the four elements: water, earth, fire and air. Many

believe the Minor Arcana help describe daily activities. Cups describe relationships and emotions we have. Pentacles show how we create better foundations and deal with the material possessions within. Wands describe our creative passions and impulses as we learn to master them. Swords represent how we communicate and manage conflict.

Each Minor Arcana suit also has four Court Cards. In the *Heaven and Earth Tarot*, these are Princesses, Knights, Queens, Kings. Princesses are feminine energy and describe young people who explore their suit's symbol. Knights are fierce warriors who use their suit's symbol to empower themselves or others. Queens are women using the suit's symbol to heal aspects of the world. Kings are leaders who hold the mantle of mastery for each suit.

USING THE CARDS

Tarot helps many people get clarity on areas in their life. The cards can also be used for other purposes like meditation focuses, creativity boosters, or whatever your mind can come up with! That said, this booklet focuses solely on helping you use the cards as a divination tool.

When you are ready to do your first reading, think of a question you want an answer. The best questions to ask Tarot are open-ended ones. These start with who, what, where, when or how. Take the time to hone in on what is going on in your life. After all, you are turning to Tarot for advice. A well thought out question can help focus the information you re-

ceive from the cards. Questions such as “How can I change to bring love into my life?” or “What can I do to be more creative?” yields better results than “Who will I marry?” or “Will I get the job offer?”

After you have a good question, hold the cards in your hand and shuffle them. There is no right or wrong way to shuffle the cards. As the cards mix, keep your question at the forefront of your mind—hold it there. Focusing on the question while you shuffle helps you remember what you’re asking. It gives you space to allow spirit to help select the cards for your answer. When you feel your deck is properly blended, stop shuffling.

Many readers use spreads, purposefully designed patterns, to set the cards in. Spreads come in all sizes and shapes, from self-designed to pre-created. They can be one card or use all 78 cards. Later in the book, you will find some spreads specifically designed for the *Heaven and Earth Tarot* to try out.

The simplest spread is a single card used to answer your question. All you need to do is look at the card, let the imagery speak to you, and write down what you think it says. If you feel stuck, or lost in what is being said, flip through this booklet to unlock what the card might be trying to tell you. Be creative and allow your imagination to guide you into how you want to use the cards. Draw cards from the top, or the bottom of the deck.

When you are done with the reading, pick up all the cards and shuffle them back into the deck. This way the deck will be ready for your next reading.

You can also use the cards as a meditative focus. Tarot cards aren’t just 78 pieces of paper with pretty im-

ages on them. With the power of your imagination and your five senses, you can step into the world of the *Heaven and Earth Tarot* and engage with the images as you've never done before.

This booklet gave you many questions you can use to journal and meditate on. Shuffle the deck, pull a card and look over the questions. Choose one which resonates with you and then spend some time in meditative thought. Grab your journal and write down the answer you think is best at the moment.

SPREAD: WHERE WILL YOU GO AND WHAT DO YOU NEED?




For this spread, you can just arrange the cards in a single line, and then interpret them in sequence.

1. Where are you in the current moment?
2. What caused this?
3. Where will you go?
4. How can you get what you need?

SPREAD: AS ABOVE, SO BELOW

The concept of “As Above, so Below” is deeply connected to the concept of Heaven and Earth. The Spiritual (Heaven, Above) and the Material (Earth, Below) mirror each other, echo each other and are connected one to the other. Rising from the Below to the Above is the journey we must take to grow as humans, to realize our dreams, to achieve our aspirations, and to find a greater harmony in our life.



A. Shuffle your deck. Lay down cards 1-3. These cards relate to your goals or aspirations. The items you desire from above (as above). Read them as they relate to one another, like a story.

B. Lay down cards 4-6. These cards relate to what is going on in your daily life (so below). Also, read them as they relate to one another.

C. Lay down cards 7-9. These three cards are the bridge - the path which gets you from “so below” to “as above”.

Ogni carta mette in evidenza il collegamento fra le corrispondenze Celestiali: l'alfabeto ebreo così come il significato dei Tarocchi. Le immagini mettono in luce i modi per vedere più chiaramente come gli elementi Mondani sono collegati con quelli Celesti nel mondo terreno. Le carte mettono a fuoco idee ed

immagini che possono sembrare non chiare ma, una volta fatti i collegamenti, i messaggi possono essere comunicati ad ogni persona che effettua una lettura con il mazzo.

Il mazzo – in modo analogo ai Tarocchi del 1909 di Arthur Edward Waite e Pamela Colman Smith – segue a volte il simbolismo cristiano. Tuttavia, il collegamento fra il Divino – o, come alcuni potrebbero dire, l’Io Superiore ed il Mondo Spirituale – ed il Mondano – o l’Io Inferiore e il Mondo Materiale – è lo stesso indipendentemente dal credo: l’umanità vive sulla Terra, ma è in cerca del Paradiso.

El Heaven and Earth Tarot (*El Tarot del Cielo y de la Tierra*) presenta la gloria de los Cielos de una manera que nos permite conectarnos con esta cada día. Esta baraja es para aquellos que ven lo Divino en lo cotidiano. Los vínculos entre el mundo terrenal y el espiritual aparecen en cada carta de la baraja. Las imágenes de esta baraja funden el sistema Waite Smith con la sabiduría oculta más profunda de una baraja de Thoth.

Cada carta pone de relieve el vínculo entre las correspondencias Celestiales: el alfabeto hebreo así como el significado del Tarot. Las imágenes arrojan luz sobre las maneras de ver más claramente cómo los elementos Mundanos están vinculados con los Celestes en el mundo terrenal. Las cartas apuntan

La baraja –de forma similar al Tarot de 1909 de Arthur Edward Waite y Pamela Colman Smith– sigue a veces el simbolismo cristiano. No obstante, el vínculo entre lo Divino -o, como podrían decir algunos, el Yo Superior y el Mundo Espiritual- y lo Mundano -o el Yo Inferior y el Mundo Material- es el mismo independientemente del credo: la humanidad vive en la Tierra, pero busca el Paraíso.

En todas las Cartas Numeradas (de 1 a 10) de cada palo aparecen palabras clave en inglés. Se presupone que las palabras clave pueden ayudar a guiar al Lector, sin limitar sus intuiciones. Le Heaven and Earth Tarot (*Tarot du Ciel et de la Terre*) présente la gloire du Ciel d'une manière qui nous permet de nous connecter à elle tous les jours. Ce jeu est destiné à ceux qui voient le Divin au quotidien. Les liens entre le monde terrestre et le monde spirituel apparaissent sur chaque carte du jeu. Les images de ce jeu mêlent le système Waite Smith à la sagesse occulte plus profonde d'un jeu de Thoth. Chaque carte met en évidence le lien entre les correspondances Célestes: l'alphabet hébreïque ainsi que la signification du Tarot. Les images permettent de discerner plus clairement la manière dont les éléments Terrestres sont liés aux éléments Célestes dans le monde d'ici-bas. Les cartes révèlent des idées et des images pouvant apparaître peu com-

préhensibles mais, une fois les liens établis, les messages s'avèrent explicites à toute personne effectuant un tirage avec le jeu.

Tout comme le Tarot de 1909 d'Arthur Edward Waite et de Pamela Colman Smith, ce jeu suit parfois la symbolique chrétienne. Cependant, le lien entre le Divin - ou, comme certains l'appellent, le Moi Supérieur et le Monde Spirituel - et le Terrestre - ou le Moi Inférieur et le Monde Matériel - est le même indépendamment de la croyance: l'humanité vit sur la Terre, mais elle est à la recherche du Paradis.

HEAVEN & EARTH TAROT

O Tarô do Céu e da Terra

“Eu não lhe ordenei? Seja forte e corajoso. Não tenha medo ou consternação, porque o Eterno, o seu Deus, está com você onde quer que você vá.”

- Josué 1:9

O Heaven and Earth Tarot (O Tarô do Céu e da Terra) apresenta a glória do céu de uma maneira que nos permite conectar com ela todos os dias. Este baralho é para quem vê o Divino na vida cotidiana. As conexões entre o mundo terrestre e o espiritual aparecem em cada carta do baralho. As imagens neste baralho combinam o sistema de Waite Smith com a sabedoria oculta mais profunda de um baralho de Thoth.

Cada carta destaca a conexão entre as correspondências Celestiais: o alfabeto hebraico, bem como o significado do Tarô. As imagens destacam as maneiras de ver mais claramente como os elementos Mundanos estão conectados com os elementos Celestes no mundo terrestre. As cartas se concentram

em ideias e imagens que podem parecer pouco claras, mas, depois de terem sido feitas as conexões, as mensagens podem ser comunicadas a cada pessoa que faz uma leitura com o baralho.

O baralho - semelhante ao Tarô de 1909, de Arthur Edward Waite e Pamela Colman Smith - às vezes segue o simbolismo cristão. Contudo, a conexão entre o Divino - ou, como alguns podem dizer, o Ego Superior e o Mundo Espiritual - e o Mundano - ou o Ego Inferior e o Mundo Material - é a mesma, independentemente da crença: a humanidade vive na Terra, mas está em busca do paraíso.

OS SIGNIFICADOS DO TARÔ DO CÉU E DA TERRA

Em todas as Cartas Numeradas (de 1 a 10) de cada naipe, estão escritas a palavra-chave em inglês. Supõe-se que as palavras-chave possam ajudar e orientar o Leitor, sem limitar as suas intuições. Eu sou apenas um naipe, um ponto de partida para a interpretação. Durante as primeiras Leituras com esse baralho, as palavras-chave provavelmente serão usadas com mais frequência, mas à medida que a experiência aumenta, um Leitor aprenderá a ir além de meras palavras, apreendendo significados mais profundos para suas interpretações.
