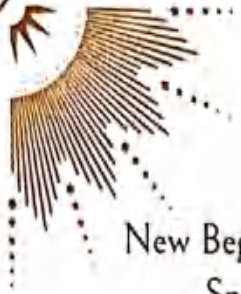
THE FOOL

Affirmation

"I trust in the journey ahead and have the courage to take risks and embrace new opportunities."

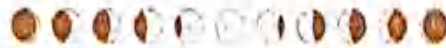

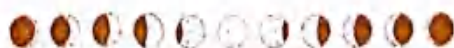




THE MAGICIAN

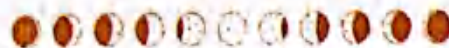




THE HIGH PRIESTESS

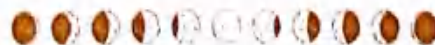




THE CHARIOT

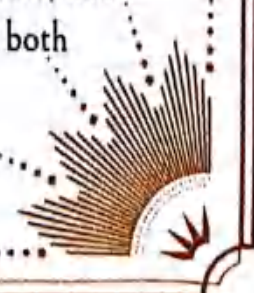

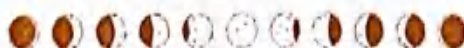




THE HERMIT
